RULES OF PLAY

Setup

- · Place all prompt cards face-down (the side with blanks facing up) in a pile
- · Choose a category (Relationship, Career, Self-Help, News Flash)
- · The first editor is the person who first read the rules
- · Take cards:
 - Each columnist takes a "fill-in-the-blank" prompt from that category (do not look at the actual prompt!)
 - Each columnist fills in the blank(s) based on the requirements for each blank of their prompt card (30s)
 - The editor draws a "breaking news" card, which they can play at any point in the round

Procedure

- · Pass the filled-in cards to the columnist to the right
- Next columnist thinks of a **solution** for the problem and **draws that solution** (2 min)
 - · Don't draw just the problem itself!
- · After time is up, each columnist comes up with a (clickbait-like) headline for their submission
- \cdot Now all columnists have 30 seconds to come up with a presentation
- · All columnists presents to the group
 - · The editor picks who presents first
- · After everyone presents, columnists may argue to convince the editor to pick their story
- · The editor chooses the presentation they liked the most
 - · The columnist who wins gets their story published and wins a token!
- · The person to the right of the editor becomes the new editor
- · Repeat!
- · Person with most tokens at the end wins
